**WHO ARE WE VOTING FOR?** Governor, Lt. Governor, U.S. Senate, U.S. House of Representatives, PA Senate (even-numbered districts), PA State Representative, and one ballot question.

**HAVE YOU MOVED?** Confirm your polling location here: [www.bit.ly/checkvotereg](http://www.bit.ly/checkvotereg) You can vote at your old polling place one more time if you have moved.

**NEED ID?** You only need ID if it is your first time voting at a new polling site, otherwise, you DO NOT need ID to vote. Acceptable forms of ID include a valid PA driver's/non-driver's license, a voter registration card, valid passport, federal government ID card, valid student ID, firearm permit, a current utility bill, bank statement, paycheck, or government check.

**NAME NOT ON THE LIST?** Ask a poll worker to call the Board of Elections to find out where you should vote or call Vote for Homes, 215-232-7272.

**PROVISIONAL BALLOT:** If you are told you may not vote for any reason you can request a provisional ballot (paper ballot). Ask for a receipt.

**WHO CAN VOTE IN PA?** Citizens over the age of 18 and who registered before October 9, 2018. You can vote if you are on probation or on parole, serving time for a misdemeanor, in jail awaiting trial, on house arrest, or have a previous felony.

**NEED HELP VOTING?** Voters may choose someone to assist them in the voting booth. Anyone can help them *except* the voter's union representative, employer, or the Judge of Elections. A *Vote For Homes* volunteer may assist you if you wish.

**CHALLENGES:** If *pollwatchers* challenge your right to vote – ask for an affidavit and have another voter in your division verify your identity. Call Vote For Homes at 215-232-7272 if your vote is challenged.
